The aging process of the skin

Hyaluronic Acid or HA, is a naturally occurring sugar found in our body and fulfills important functions such as maintaining moisture and volume in the skin.

Environmental factors such as sun exposure, pollution, and free radicals as well as the natural aging process have an influence on the depletion of HA in the skin. HA levels decline over time resulting in skin that becomes thinner, drier and less supple. This leads to the appearance of lines and wrinkles, and loss of volume which changes the harmony of the face.

What is Croma HA?

The Croma portfolio of HA dermal fillers are specially designed to meet specific patients needs.

Croma RICH: To replenish the loss of HA, to improve tone and elasticity of the skin.

Croma FILLER: For the treatment of moderate to severe facial wrinkles and folds and to increase lip volume.

Croma VOLUME Lidocaine: For the treatment of deeper wrinkles and folds, increase or restore volume to the face and to remodel facial contours.

Croma VOLUME PLUS Lidocaine: For the treatment of moderate to severe midface volume deficit.
